Engineering, Construction & AGRI Foods

Blundstone style boots with steel caps which are compulsory for most work placements plus overalls

VET Hospitality

Fully covered leather shoes are a legal requirement that must be worn whilst working in the kitchen. (ie. leather school shoes)

*DigitL SLR Camera - highly recommended. School uses Nikon D3100 Digital SLR with 18-55mm lens. On sale normally at Harvey Norman. Sandisk ultra 8GB memory card (to be kept in the classroom for safe keeping).

Students in Years 3-10 are required to bring to school, a fully charged and functional iPad each day as part of the College "Bring Your Own Device" Program. In 2020, the minimum requirements for a student iPad:

- iPad Air 2 (2014) or newer
- iPad (5th Generation, 2017) or newer
- iPad Pro (2015) or newer

Older devices will not be an acceptable option. If you need to purchase a new iPad, the 2019 10.2inch iPad (iPad 7) is the recommended option.

If an outright purchase of the iPad creates financial hardship for families, there is an opportunity to pay a device levy of \$120.00 per year and be provided with a College device. Further information can be obtained from the College office.

***Food Studies requirements**

2 Tea towels clearly named

1 Storage container with a well fitting lid that is suitable to take home baked products (an ice-cream container).

The following Subjects don't require stationery - Religious Education, Digital Technologies and Horticulture

***Outdoor Education requirements**

Thermal long sleeve top and long johns (polypropylene or polyester)

These should be purchased from "outdoor" suppliers

***VET requirements (Construction, Engineering and Agrifoods)**

Certificate 1 - Overalls

Students should already have some of the items listed above, in which case they should not be re-ordered.

Safety boots steel top caps. Safety glasses, work pants or overalls (Hard Yakka or King Gee style), hat (outdoor work).
