A new school year – a great time to get that new bank account started for your child.

Cygnet Bendigo Bank will this year be offering a <u>Student Banking Service</u> through your local Cygnet Branch. Bank deposits can be brought along to school <u>on a Tuesday</u> and staff from Bendigo will collect books and return them to the school the following day.

Students can have a Bendigo EasyMoney Card (if you're 12 or over) or a Bendigo Blue Debit (if you're 16 or over).
